Thanks to this, all of them will be able to enrich their curriculum vitae, gain work experience, complement their training, increase their chances of getting a job, etc.

### WHAT PROBLEMS HAVE ARISEN?

- I do volunteer work, but it is not reflected
- I find it difficult to find work related to children if I don't have previous experience.
- I have volunteered in the camp, but my work has not been officially recognised.
- I would like to prove my volunteering with a certificate.
- I want to complement my training with the work I did as an animator in this youth centre.
- I could increase my chances of getting a job if my work was recognised.

## WHY DO WE CHOOSE TO RECOGNISE VOLUNTEERING?

We realised the importance of recognising the work of all these young people as a reward and for their own personal benefit, as well as to increase the number of people who volunteer over the years.



### WHAT SOLUTIONS DO WE VALUE?

- To make visible and raise awareness of the importance of volunteering.
- To certify the work of young people at the Don Bosco Youth Centre in Villamuriel (Palencia).
- To do this through the RECONOCE platform.

### WHY DID WE CHOOSE THIS SOLUTION?

It was a novel and useful way to reward the time and effort dedicated by our young people. By carrying out this initiative, it was intended to have a global reach given the importance of volunteering.

- · Achieving the global reach of volunteering is more complex than it seemed.








