The intermediate meeting of the project "GreEn: entrepreneurship's for the present and future of Europe and Latin America", cofinanced by the Erasmus Plus programme, was held in Cordoba (Argentina) in hybrid format from 29 February to 1 March.

This meeting has served to discuss the status of the project so that, during the first day, the entity made a summary of the activities carried out so far and those that are still pending.

The summary of the project's quality monitoring was presented and a new dissemination strategy was proposed.

In addition, the progress of the tests by the partner organisations was presented and new strategies, challenges and achievements were shared in order to continue advancing and improving the implementation of the tests.

Priorities were also set for the organisation of the second transnational training that will take place in Montevideo (Uruguay) in May, in which participants from each entity will have to present two entrepreneurial ideas created from the tests carried out during the previous months.
